FIELD SAFETY RULES VOTED INTO EFFECT AUGUST 4TH, 1998

1. ALL flyers must be current members of AMA.
2. FIRST priority upon arriving at the field, put your transmitter in the IMPOUND AREA, making sure the transmitter is OFF.
3. When you remove your frequency pin from the box (making sure you have the CORRECT pin), REPLACE the pin with your CURRENT AMA CARD.
4. You have 15 MINUTES to use the frequency. When your flight is over, return the transmitter and frequency pin DIRECTLY to the IMPOIND AREA.
5. Be sure your frequency is clear BEFORE turning the radio on.
6. When starting your engine, make sure it faces AWAY from the spectators.
7. All engines MUST have mufflers.
8. When ready to fly, you can taxi to the flight line. When you finish your flight, SHUT YOUR ENGINE OFF at the FLIGHT LINE.
9. Pilots MUST stand in one of the designated pads while flying.
10. No flying over highway 71.
11. Make sure you know where the club's FIRST AID KIT is located.
12. Minor members will fly ONLY when their parent of guardian is present.
13. The club will not be responsible for personal items left at the club field. Members or guests personal property left at the field will not be replaced by the club if lost, damaged or stolen.

GENERAL ARTICLE Anyone operating a model aircraft in an unsafe manner and is reported by club members to the Board of Directors, shall be subject to corrective action as directed by the board.
